Strategic Initiatives

Governance Structure

The Appraisal Institute's current governance structure dates to its formation in 1991 as a result of the merger of two proud predecessor organizations. This structure should keep pace with market changes and provide greater value to all Al professionals.

The Appraisal Institute Board of Directors created a project team in 2015 to make recommendations to the Board for possibly enhancing the overall Al governance structure, and to find the optimum mix of member services and the efficient delivery of those services. The Governance Structure Project Team (GSPT) was directed to focus on determining the best ways to provide member value, considering current market realities.

The project team provided its recommendations to the Board in June 2017 and in a report in May 2018. The Board is now seeking input from Al professionals.

Governance Structure Project Team Report

The Appraisal Institute would very much appreciate the input of AI professionals regarding the project team's recommendations.

The Al would like to post on the Al website feedback from Al Professionals on the Project Team report. While the Al would like to take this step to enhance transparency and discussion of these issues, the Al also would like to respect the desire of some Al professionals who would like to participate but wish for privacy. Further, the Al would like to encourage robust and frank input on the project team's report; some may be hesitant to provide such input if it will be widely available.

Therefore, the AI has created three options from which AI Professionals can select regarding posting and distribution of their comments. Of course, comments published to the AI Professionals portion of the AI website ultimately may see wider distribution.
